Membership Meeting
February 25, 2009

President Paul Keysaw called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Minutes of the January meeting were read by Secretary Mike Kelly. Motion by Jordan; seconded by Anthony to accept minutes as read. Passed unanimously.

Treasurers Report was read by Treasurer Dale Anthony. Motion by Bean; seconded by Rosenberger to accept report. Passed unanimously. The Treasurer's Report is posted on the bulletin board at the Clubhouse monthly.

Old Business:

Pond weed control – a discussion was held. Kelly asked to get an estimate for approximately a five-acre pond.

Maintenance of Skeet Machines: A solid-state circuit board was installed on the machine that was malfunctioning. All machines were maintained by a Shyda representative. It was noted that all trap machines should be thoroughly maintained annually. Randy Cornell and Bill Jordan worked with the Shyda Rep to understand the maintenance procedures. Cost of this work was approximately \$650, plus parts. A motion was made by Ed Moore Jr. and seconded by Ed Dawejko to purchase the tools necessary to maintain the machines and a locked toolbox to store them. Motion passed.

New Business:

A suggestion was made by Ed Dawejko to purchase 3D archery targets. He suggested fifteen (15). He was asked to come back with cost estimates.

Anton Vatnitsky suggested we maintain the 200-yard rifle range better. Anton was asked to contact Dan Barrett and work out a plan of action.

Annual Banquet: Motion made by Anthony and seconded by Jordan to have the Banquet on Saturday, May 16, 2009.

Motion was passed with John Crossett voting against. Social Hour will start at 4 pm; meal at 6 pm, and meeting at 7 pm.

Anthony will contact Litchfield Volunteer Fire Department for a menu and to see if they are interested in catering the event. Directors with terms expiring this year are Keysaw, Kelly, and Rosenberger.
