Old Business:

- ◆ Survival course –not enough people signed up.

- ◆ Club Rental Rates: - Motion passed to set rate at \$100 for members and \$200 for non-members. Other stipulations also apply, such as, one Club Director must be present.
- ◆ Committee formed to refurbish the kitchen.
- ◆ There was ongoing discussion about how to fix the lights on Skeet field 2.

New Business:

- ◆ Discussion about when to start selling 2010-2011 membership cards. They went on sale March 1, 2010. Cost is \$45.
- ◆ Motion passed to send a letter to two police departments that memberships must be purchased for anyone using our facilities (instead of one membership for the whole department).
